

NYSHC 48th Annual Fall Pleasure Ride

Directions, Registration & Guidelines Information

DIRECTIONS: www.madisoncountyfairny.com/

- From the north (Utica) NY Route 8 South to Bridgewater. Turn right onto Route 20. Stay in left hand lane. Proceed west for approximately 2 miles. Turn left onto Bliven Road (at top of Hill). Follow Bliven Road to Fairground Road. Turn left onto Fairground Road and proceed to the Madison County Fairground in the Village of Brookfield.
- Rt. 12 South to Sangersfield: turn left to Rt. 20 east. One mile east of Sangersfield, still on Rt. 20, turn right on Beaver Creek Rd.-look for sign: " Brookfield 8 miles." Travel on Beaver Creek Rd. and enter village of Brookfield. Turn left on Elm St. at Baptist Church. At stop sign, school will be in front of you, turn left and you will be there in a few seconds.
- From the East: Route 20 West to Bridgewater; turn left at light to Rt. 8 South. Travel four miles south. Turn right on Skaneateles Turnpike Rd.-marked by Brookfield sign. Travel four miles into village. On entering village, take first right to Fairground Rd., you are about 30 seconds away from the Fairground.

- PLEASE notify ASAP if your plans changed and unable to attend, as we have a waiting list
- If you do not notify prior to the dates listed below **Cancellation fees** will be charged:
 - **Prior to September 1st - \$15.00 per person**
 - **After September 1st - \$35.00 per person, minimum**
 - **Refunded amount will determine the ability to rent stall(s) or sell ordered meal tickets**
- 2015 or 2016 Coggins Certificate and proof of Current 2016 Rabies Vaccination are required for all horses, mules or donkeys

GET YOUR REGISTRATION PACKET:

- Friday, 12:00pm – 6:00 pm. Please stop at the Registration Office Building, Main Entrance of Madison County Fairgrounds to pick up your Registration Packets & register for fun activities (usually before you park or unload). There will be refreshments!
- If you arrived earlier than Friday, you'll need to pay for camping and stall daily rental fees direct to Karen Wheeler
- Friday, 6:00pm-8:00pm. Registration will be at the Whitford Dining Hall
- Saturday, 8:00am - 11:00am. Registration will be at the Whitford Dining Hall
- All Dog's must have Rabies Certificate and Licensed, please bring documentation to registration

FAIRGROUNDS:

- Seventy (70) sites are available for electric hookup. Seven (7) sites have sewage hookup. Registrants will receive a Hook-Up Card to place on your vehicle windshield
- Sewage & Electric Hookup Sites: Unless you are registered for one of these sites, PLEASE DO NOT block, set-up or plug-in to a hookup site with truck, camper, trailer, or corral
- Camping sites are first-come first-serve basis
- Portable corrals may be set up on camping sites on the north side of the center entrance road which leads to the barns, behind the barns and in field beside the outdoor arena
- Please limit size of fenced area and do not block an electric hookup
- Campers may not drain gray water onto the ground
- Generators may only be run between 9:00am and 9:00pm

STALLS/BARN:

- The numbers of stalls are limited. No rental stalls are available for storage of tack
- Sawdust is provided for stall bedding and located in a covered area in-between the barns
- Wheelbarrows and shovels are available for your use. Keep the forks, etc. at end of barn
- Please store your hay and feed in your trailer. For safety, we need to eliminate aisle clutter
- Thoroughly **STRIP** your stall(s) before leaving or you will be charged \$25 cleaning fee!!

OTHER:

- The outdoor ring is to be shared by all for brief 1/2 hour or less for turnout or riding
- Dogs must be on leash at all times and **please** scoop the poop! Dogs are not permitted in the dining hall or in the barns. Dogs may not be tied in a stall
- Please notify if you have personal or food special needs
- A message board is available for your use in the Whitford Dining Hall
