

## NYSHC 53<sup>rd</sup> ANNUAL FALL PLEASURE RIDE INFORMATION & REMINDERS

This event is sponsored by the NEW YORK STATE HORSE COUNCIL which officially starts Friday October 7, 2022 at 9am, and ends Monday, October, 10, 2022 no later than 2:00pm. You **MUST** be registered at the Madison County Fairgrounds to participate at this weekend event.

- From the north (Utica) NY Route 8 South to Bridgewater. Turn right onto Route 20. Stay in left hand lane. Proceed west for approximately 2 miles. Turn left onto Bliven Road (at top of Hill). Follow Bliven Road to Fairground Road. Turn left onto Fairground Road and proceed to the Madison County Fairground in the Village of Brookfield.
- Rt. 12 South to Sangersfield: turn left to Rt. 20 east. One mile east of Sangersfield, still on Rt. 20, turn right on Beaver Creek Rd.-look for sign: " Brookfield 8 miles." Travel on Beaver Creek Rd. and enter village of Brookfield. Turn left on Elm St. at Baptist Church. At stop sign, school will be in front of you, turn left and you will be there in a few seconds.
- From the East: Route 20 West to Bridgewater; turn left at light to Rt. 8 South. Travel four miles south. Turn right on Skaneateles Turnpike Rd.-marked by Brookfield sign. Travel four miles into village. On entering village, take first right to Fairground Rd., you are about 30 seconds away from the Fairground.

- Registration starts Saturday, 6/18/22 and ends Saturday, 9/17/22 utilizing RSVPBook.com ONLINE or NYSHC Postal Mail Printable Form (if you prefer not to utilize RSVPBOOK.com ONLINE REGISTRATION, please utilize the POSTAL MAIL PRINTABLE FORM). After this date, we cannot guarantee availability. Cancellation notices received prior to 9/17/22 will receive full refund minus \$35.00 processing fee. Cancellations after 9/17/22 are non-refundable. Please notify ASAP if your plans changed and unable to attend, as we have a waiting list.

### GET YOUR REGISTRATION PACKET:

- Please stop at the Registration Office, before you park or unload to pick up your Registration Packets which includes; confirmation, meal tickets, hook-up signs, stall assignments (if applicable), wrist band, name badge, raffle ticket. Please be sure to wear your name badge Friday, Saturday and Sunday evening at the Whitford Hall. Plus, register for fun activities and don't forget to bring cash or your checkbook! There will be refreshments! The office is located alongside the main building (sign will be posted).
- Thursday "Early Arrivals". Please stop by the office to check in if open.
- Friday, 12:00pm-6:00pm. Event officially opens. Registration at the Office.
- Friday, 6:00pm-8:00pm. Registration moved to Whitford Dining Hall.
- Saturday, 8:00am-11:00am. Registration Packets at Whitford Dining Hall.
- Please be sure to bring your current Coggins Certificate and proof of current Rabies vaccinations for horse, mule or donkey and/or dog.

### FAIRGROUNDS / CAMPSITES:

- Camp sites are first-come, first serve basis.
- Seventy (70) sites available for electric hookup.
- Seven (7) sites have designated sewage and electric hookup. Unless you are registered for one of these sites, PLEASE DO NOT block, set-up or plug-in to a hookup with truck, camper, trailer or corral.
- Campers may not drain gray water onto the ground.
- Rustic Site/Portable Corrals may be set up at the north side of the center entrance road which leads to the barns and in field next to the outdoor arena. Camping is free if no hookups are utilized. Please limit size of fenced area, and do not block electric hookup. Your campsites must be clean of debris during and after departing.
- Generators may only be run between 9am-9pm.

### STALLS/BARNES:

- Barn #1 and Barn #2 are box stalls. Barn #3 are open stalls. Stalls are limited, assigned first-come, first serve basis.
- Stall shavings, forks and wheelbarrows are available located between Barn #1 & Barn #2 under a covered shed, please return them after each use.
- Please store your hay, feed, and/or tack at your campsite.
- Stalls must be stripped and empty by Monday (around 12pm) before you leave. You will be charged \$25.00 clean up fee if left as is.

### OTHER:

- The outdoor ring should be shared by all for a brief ½ hour for turnout or riding.
- Dogs must be on a leash at ALL times, please scoop the poop! Dogs are not permitted in the dining hall.
- Face masks are optional when outdoors or indoors. Please consider COVID Safety Measures at your discretion. Sanitizer and Face Masks will be provided onsite.
- Please let us know if you have special needs.
