## 2022 NYSHC Ride/Drive Program

NYS Horse Council members can receive recognition for their hours spent in the saddle or in the seat of a carriage. This is open to all paid members of all ages. It is a great way to keep track of exactly how much time you spend out riding or driving with your equine buddy plus it can be a motivator to get out there and ride or drive.

To participate, member dues must be paid for the current year. Keep track of your hours ridden or driven on the log sheet that can be downloaded (or you can keep track on your computer) from the NYSHC webpage, nyshc.org, Awards, Ride & Drive. There are a number of free cell phone apps that are available to help keep track of time. Here are just a few: MapMyRun, MapMyRide (I used both of these), Sports Tracker, Maprika, Geo tracker, just to name a few. There is an initial \$15 registration fee for the first year. After the first year, there is a \$5 registration fee. More information can be found on the NYSHC webpage.

For 2022, the registration fee was waived. This helped bring in 7 new participants. For 2023, we are returning to the \$15/\$5 fee. Hopefully, this will not discourage members from participating.
